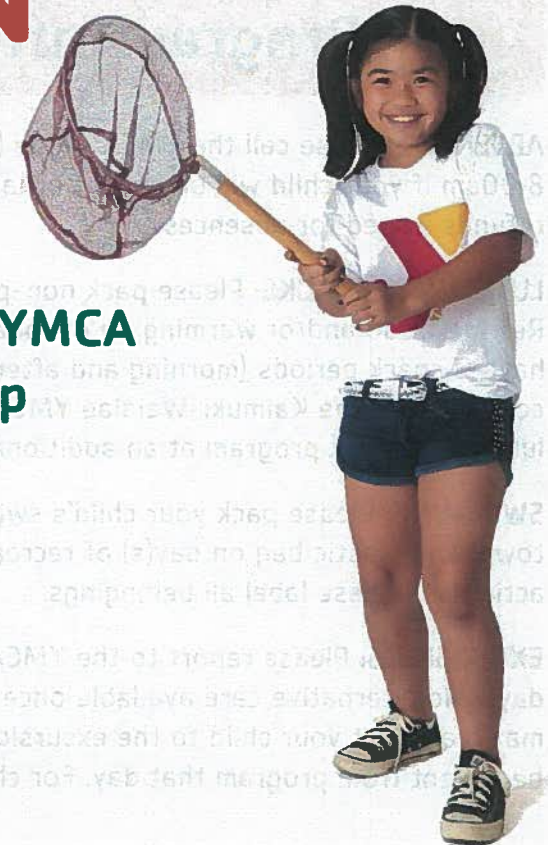

Program Information

ABSENCES: Please call the YMCA office (808-737-5544) no later than 8:00am if your child will be absent or late. There are no credits or refunds issued for absences.

LUNCH AND SNACKS: Please pack non-perishable lunch and snacks. Refrigeration and/or warming up of food will not be available. We have 2 snack periods (morning and afternoon) per day. For your convenience, the Kaimuki-Waiialae YMCA is able to offer an optional lunch and snack program at an additional cost.

SWIMMING: Please pack your child's swimsuit, change of clothes, towel and plastic bag on day(s) of recreational swim and/or water activities. Please label all belongings.

EXCURSIONS: Please report to the YMCA by 8:00am on excursion days. No alternative care available once the bus has departed. You may transport your child to the excursion location or have your child be absent from program that day. For children to participate in all

off-site activities and excursions, parents/guardians will be required to sign an Excursion Waiver. Waiver forms are due on the first program day.

Registration Information

REGISTRATION: Register online at www.ymcahonolulu.org, by mail, or in person at the Kaimuki-Waiialae YMCA. Space is limited. Register early.

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION POLICY: Payment must be made prior to the start of the program. The YMCA will assess a \$20 service charge for every returned credit card draft or check. Please call the Kaimuki-Waiialae YMCA at 737-5544 as soon as possible if you need to change your child's program. Cancellations must be in writing and received at least 7 days prior to the start of the program. \$50 is non-refundable. All refunds are subject to a \$15 processing fee. No refunds or credits once program starts. The YMCA reserves the right to make program changes due to enrollment.

DHS REIMBURSEMENT PAPERWORK: Program payment in full is required in order to complete DHS 918 form.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: The Kaimuki-Waiialae YMCA believes its programs and services should be accessible to everyone. Through the generosity of donors, the YMCA is able to provide financial assistance to those families in need.
